Terms and conditions of Entry.

**2 wrist bands will be issued with your first entry,
additional entries will receive 1 wristband & must be worn on arrival.
Please note additional wrist bands are available to purchase at the paybox.
Visitors & guests must pay gate prices.**

- 1. ALL WORKING EXHIBITS MUST BE INSURED FOR PUBLIC LIABILITY OF AT LEAST £2,000,000.**
Failure to produce evidence of such cover will result in immediate exclusion from the show ground.
- Wristbands must be worn prior to entering the show ground.
- Entry numbers must be displayed on the driver's side of the windscreen prior to entering the show ground.
- Caravan passes must be displayed in caravan prior to entering the show ground.
- Caravans will be parked under instruction and if necessary positioned by the steward.
- Canopies / Awnings / Gazebo's will only be allowed for stalls and displays.
- Exhibits must be in a safe condition whether in operation or not.
- Vehicles must be in full working order (i.e. must be able to be driven under their own power)
- Stationary Engines and Machinery must be at least six feet behind a barrier.
- Tractors will carry only one person regardless of the type of seating fitted.
- Steam vehicles will carry a maximum of two people unless specifically fitted otherwise.
- No one will be carried other than in the passenger space of a commercial vehicle.
- Boiler Inspection Certificates must be brought to the event. Failure to produce these on request will result in immediate exclusion from the show ground.
- Passengers may be carried on motorcycles only if a proper seat and footrests are fitted and used.
- All exhibitors & trade are required to be present no later than 09.30 on each day of attendance.
- To drive any vehicle on the show ground you must have a current valid driving licence covering the category/class of vehicle you are driving (and must be shown on request).
- A speed limit of 5mph will apply on the show ground at all times.
- All equipment fitted to the electricity supply must be wired and fused in accordance with the Electricity Regulations.
- No drones are allowed on or above the site.
- No open fires, fire pits, fireworks, chinese lanterns or disposable BBQ's.
- Due to health and safety regulations all portable appliances and extension leads must have a current annual test certificate of safety. **Health and Safety officer Richard Calvert.**
- Portable Generators – must have residual circuit breakers and earth rods.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and cleaned up after.
- No vehicle movement on the field between 10:00 & 16.30 unless escorted by a steward.
- All vehicles, caravans and exhibits must be removed from the showground no later than 17:00 on the Tuesday immediately following the show.
- The committee's decision on all matters is final.
- Late arrivals after 10:00am will be held in a designated area awaiting the arrival of the appropriate steward.**

CONDITION OF ENTRY

The driver of any vehicle on the Show Ground **must** hold a valid driving licence applicable to that vehicle and must also have minimum insurance for that vehicle as required by the Road Traffic Act. The Chipping Steam Fair Committee reserves the right to refuse admission to any exhibitor / visitor.

Declaration: I declare that during the whole period of the event my entry will be covered by **Public Liability Insurance** of no less than £2,000,000 (including boiler explosions on the steam exhibits). Advised £5,000.000 for Barn Engines, Commercials, Steam Engines (all sizes), Military & Classic Plant.

I agree to abide by all health and safety regulations. In default of the foregoing, I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the organisers of the event.
